IOSH WORKING SAFELY

Upon completion of the IOSH Working Safely course you will have a foundational understanding of **good working practices in the workplace** to ensure you and others are kept safe.



This course has 8 hours of study time required.

This course is typically completed within 1 day.



You have access to this course for 6 months from the date of enrolment. This course is RQF level 1, SQF Level 3 and NQF Level 2.



This course is designed for all employees who require a base understanding of health and safety.

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The IOSH Working Safely course is for anyone, in any sector, at any career level who requires a base understanding and qualification in health and safety.

This qualification is an accessible entry level qualification that is intended to ensure a base **awareness of general health and safety issues** around the workplace. This certification covers the identification and definition of common dangers and risks, enhancing safety practices, and safeguarding the environment. Assessing involves a multiple choice question assessment and a hazard spotting exercise, both of which can be completed online.

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This qualification ensures the basics of understanding necessary procedures to **mitigate risks and prevent accidents**. This course is ideal for individuals aspiring to start a health and safety career, as it establishes a solid groundwork for attaining more advanced health and safety qualifications.



IOSH MANAGING SAFELY[®]

Those who complete the IOSH Managing Safely qualification will be able to **effectively oversee workplace safety**, identify and mitigate risks, and lead safety initiatives. It will enable you to ensure a secure work environment, protect employees, and enhance organisational compliance.



This course has 22 hours of study time required.

This course is typically completed within 2 weeks.



You have access to this course for 6 months from the date of enrolment. This course is RQF level 2, SQF Level 5 and NQF Level 3.



This course is aimed at those employed in managerial roles, including supervisors and team leaders.

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The IOSH Managing Safely course introduces the concepts of Safety Management Systems, teaching best practices for managing health and safety in the workplace.

This qualification serves as an **excellent starting point for employees** who are embarking on a new journey in the field of health and safety.

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The IOSH Managing safely is a key qualification for all supervisors and line managers. Accidents can happen in any workplace and avoiding them can be a simple process.

This qualification provides the **fundamentals and foundations of health and safety**, to help start your career in safety. It is recommended to study this qualification first before taking on the NEBOSH General Certificate.

This course is typically completed within 1 day.

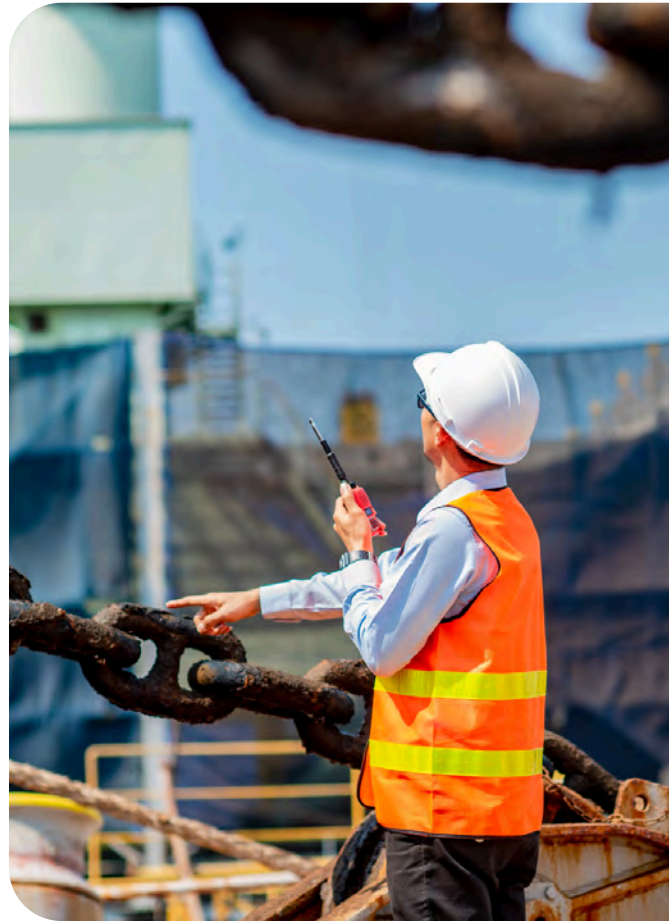
